Fundraising

This Team oversees fundraising event(s) to be held during the year; interacts with the public to secure contributions for the fundraising raffles, if needed. Issues requests for signs, advertising, publicity and makes and distributes flyers.

Gardening

Maintains existing gardening projects, Daffodil Hill, Sly Park entrance, Pinewood School Memorial Garden and the Pollock Pines Library.

Library

Helps support the Friends of the Pollock Pines Library with fundraising and weekly landscape maintenance.

Membership

Collects New Membership Applications and Member Renewals; maintains the Member Roster, sends to Members and creates Member name badge.

Program

Plans monthly events and meetings, collects monies for luncheons and special events, makes arrangements for venues and travel services, and secures speakers.

Sunshine

Plans and coordinates monthly birthday luncheons and notifies the membership of members' illnesses, deaths and births in their families and handles memorial PP library book donations honoring deceased members.

Decorating

Responsible for Christmas decorations in Pollock Pines: creating boughs and hanging them in the community and decorating the Trees for Teens Christmas tree. Additionally, the team decorates tables at the DGC Christmas Luncheon and annual fundraising luncheon.

<u>Historian</u>

Takes photos at DGC meetings and events, collects correspondence from the President and compiles this information and photos into a scrapbook which is given to the President at year-end, and then donated to the Pollock Pines Library.

The DGC dues are \$30 per calendar year, and are due no later than December 31st of each year. For an additional \$15, we will send you a monthly (10 issues per year) copy of our newsletter, "*The Bloomin' News*" by US mail. Ecologically, we prefer that you receive the newsletter via e-mail, if possible. You will not be charged the additional \$15 if you receive the Club's newsletter via e-mail.
