CEDAPP cleans the park Jan.-March. DGC has Oct.-Dec. CEDAPP has been working with ED Disposal to obtain dumpsters for the green waste clean up as opposed to having bagged up and taking it to the dump. CEDAPP has proposed to the club that we can obtain the dumpsters for the 3 months at a cost of \$121.42 per month. Total of \$364.26. This is a discount rate. We allotted in our budget \$120.00 for bags and dump fees. Cost of the dump has gone up and this would probably not cover costs at this point. CEDAPP will receive a grant from ED Disposal for \$300.00. CEDAPP would split that with us and write us a check for \$150.00. This leaves an amount of an additional \$94.26 we would need to approve to make this happen.

Questions were raised as to how illegal dumping would be prevented from the time the dumpsters were dropped off till they were picked up. Also, Rotary is no longer doing April-June green waste clean up as there is not much to clean up during these months. This leaves a number of months between October when we pick it up again and is a heavy clean up. Question was raised if Rotary could do one in between during the summer. Ginger Swigart is a Rotary member and is going to ask.

Motion was made to approve from our budget for the additional \$94.26 to obtain the dumpsters by Barbara and was seconded by Lexa.
